Daisies: K-1

Girl Scouts talk with their volunteers about their ideas for their activities.

Brownies: 2-3

Girl Scouts brainstorm ideas and volunteers help determine which are possible.

Juniors: 4-5

Girl Scouts work in groups to develop ideas they like best.

Volunteers help girls realize their goals.

Cadettes: 6-8

Girl Scouts take a larger role in planning and decision making.

Volunteers help when necessary.

Seniors: 9-10

Girl Scouts decide what they want to do and how to do it.

Volunteers guide and help as needed.

Ambassadors: 11-12

Girl Scouts rotate leadership and tasks and plan their activities, budgets, and goals.

Volunteers assist occasionally.
