

**Money Earning/Group Financing Opportunities

Marketplace is a lunchtime activity at Discoveries where troops or groups can sell items as a money earning project. Due to space limitations, only the first 20 approved troops/groups will be allowed to sell at Discoveries.

The Discoveries Planning Committee has established these guidelines.

1. Before applying to sell at Discoveries, Leaders/Advisors must consult *Safety-Wise* (standards 28 and 29) and current Girl Scouts of Western Washington polices on money-earning (Volunteer Guide).
2. No on-site or homemade food items, including espresso stands, soup mixes, or home-made cosmetics, etc. may be sold. Commercially prepared and pre-packaged foods may be sold. Hand-made items that the girls have created are good sellers.
3. You must supply your own table, not to exceed 48" by 48", for your money-earning booth.
4. You must provide information on what your troop/group plans to do with the money (poster or handouts). This will let others know how you will use your money, and increase your sales!
