NOMINATION AND APPROVAL PROCEDURES

1. **THREE** individuals or groups familiar with the service performed by the nominee each complete an HONOR PIN - NOMINATION FORM or a letter including all requested information and submit them to Girl Scouts of Western Washington Adult Recognition Committee by **January 15**. Nominators will receive an acknowledgement of receipt.
2. The Adult Recognition Committee will only review applications that contain three complete nominations, all of which have been received on time.
3. All nominators will be notified of the committee results, and successful nominees will be informed that they will receive an award at the Adult Recognition Event.

CRITERIA INCLUDE:

- Service to two or more geographical areas or service units
- Exceptional service beyond position expectations

EXAMPLES OF POSSIBLE CANDIDATES for the HONOR PIN might include, but are not limited to:

- An individual who directs a successful area wide day camp (beyond one service unit)
- An individual who manages consistently successful program events for the Girl Scouts of Western Washington.
- An individual who directs a membership outreach task group with positive results, either in terms of membership, or in targeted groups served
- An individual who manages excellent training events for parts or all of the Girl Scouts of Western Washington
- An individual who introduces Girl Scouting to the wider community through significant community action or community organization team strategy
- An association chair who has enhanced the policy decision-making process of Girl Scouts of Western Washington based on area's needs

The HONOR PIN (a GSUSA award) is a round, green enamel pin with a gold-tone trefoil and laurel wreath design.
