Criteria for Selection:

1. It is given to registered adult members of the Girl Scouts of the U. S. A. either as a volunteer or employed staff member.
2. This candidate has visibly exhibited a sincere commitment to the Girl Scout Promise and Law over an extended period of time.
3. This candidate has repeatedly inspired others to carry on the Girl Scout tradition and mission.
4. The candidate is actively supporting the goals and objectives of Girl Scouts of Western Washington.

Applications **must be postmarked January 15** in order to be considered in that calendar year. All completed applications must be sent together with four (4) supporting Letters of Endorsement. The Adult Recognition Committee reserves the right to recommend a different recognition which they feel would be more suitable. Final approval is made by the council Board of Directors.

The following steps must be taken in processing a nomination for the **NORMA RAVER TRUE GIRL SCOUT AWARD**:

1. A nomination application and four (4) letters of endorsement are received and reviewed by the Adult Recognition Committee and approved by the Board of Directors. The candidate's membership with Girl Scouts of the U. S. A. is verified by the council. Within six weeks of receipt of the completed nomination, a decision will be made and the nominating individual or group will be notified of the decision.
2. The **NORMA RAVER TRUE GIRL SCOUT AWARD** is presented at the annual council meeting.

Approval: The Adult Recognition Committee reviews the nomination form and the letters of endorsement and recommends approval or denial to the council Board of Directors. The council Board of Directors approves or denies the award and notifies the Adult Recognition Committee and nominating group or individual.
