



OPERATION COOKIE DROP 2010

Join other Girl Scouts in Girl Scouts of Western Washington in supporting the military personnel serving our country by participating in **Operation Cookie Drop**.

This is how Operation Cookie Drop works:

1. During order taking, girls ask customers to donate to Operation Cookie Drop. On the order card, the number of boxes is entered in the first (blank) column. If the customer is not ordering additional cookies for themselves, girls collect for Operation Cookie Drop cookies at the time of order. Troops deposit any money collected into their troop bank accounts (cash) and checks into council account. Contact council for more information.
2. Before site sales, troops can decorate a box and/or make signs for Operation Cookie Drop donations. There will also be a **KOMO Operation Cookie Drop** sign for each troop to put onto a box.
3. During site sales, troops display a collection box marked **OPERATION COOKIE DROP** and encourage customers to purchase cookies for donation. All varieties of cookies can be donated. Troops may wish to have markers on hand for customers to write a message of support to the military personnel on the boxes of cookies.
4. Troops bring all boxes donated for Operation Cookie Drop to the nearest Regional Girl Scout Center no later than **2:00 p.m. on March 20, 2010**.
5. Girl Scouts of Western Washington will deliver all Operation Cookie Drop cookies to the Puget Sound Area USO. All branches of the military will receive the cookies.
6. **OPERATION COOKIE DROP** patches will be available from the Girl Scout Store once the sale begins.
