**NOMINATION AND APPROVAL PROCEDURES**

1. **TWO** individuals or groups familiar with the service performed by the nominee each complete a VIVIAN CAVER DIVERSITY AWARD - NOMINATION FORM or a letter including all requested information and submit them to Girl Scouts of Western Washington Adult Recognition Committee by **January 15**. Nominators will receive an acknowledgement of receipt.
2. The Adult Recognition Committee will only review applications that contain two complete nominations, both of which have been received on time.
3. All nominators will be notified of the committee results, and successful nominees will be informed that they will receive an award at the Adult Recognition Event.

**CRITERIA INCLUDE:**

- Demonstrated commitment to diversity over a period of time; a role model to both adults and girls.
- Significant contribution to promotion of diversity and pluralism in the Girl Scout community and/or the community at large.
- Effort made to reach out to serve and to increase the involvement of diverse populations in the council.

EXAMPLES OF POSSIBLE CANDIDATES for the VIVIAN CAVER DIVERSITY AWARD might include, but are not limited to:

- An individual who develops and implements an ongoing diversity program.
- An individual who makes an ongoing effort to increase the diversity of Girl Scouts of Western Washington girl membership, or adult volunteer corps.

The VIVIAN CAVER DIVERSITY AWARD (a GSWW northwest area award) is a round gold tone pin.
