### For Your Troop

<a href="#">Application for Extended Travel</a>	Due to staff 4 months prior to travel	
<a href="#">Additional Insurance 3P or 3E Plan</a>	Due to staff 4 weeks prior to travel	
<a href="#">Certificates of Insurance</a> – Required for Lodging & Activities	Due to staff prior to travel	
<a href="#">Application for High Risk and Sensitive Topics</a> – May be required depending on activities	Due to staff 1 month prior to travel
