

# 2021 Cookie Program Girl Scout and Adult Responsibility Agreement

Girl Scouts may market their cookie sale - but not sell cookie packages - outside of the program dates.

**Digital Cookie Online Sales!** Customers can choose to have their cookies direct-shipped or hand-delivered by your Girl Scout, as health directives allow. Families are responsible for delivering all approved Girl Delivered cookies and may be charged for cookies (plus any necessary shipping costs) reported by customers as not delivered. For online package sales, all payments must be made through the virtual storefront. Look for the Digital Cookie invitation email in mid-January.

### Money

- All cookie varieties will be sold for \$5 per package
- All donations accepted must be applied towards Operation Cookie or Troop Gift of Caring programs
- Check and credit card acceptance up to each troop
- Parent/Guardians need to submit 100% of money collected to troop by 3/22 or a \$40 late fee will apply

### Specifics

- 2021 Cookie Program information is subject to change, including booth sale opportunities, due to unknown health directives that may change as we move through the program
- Girl Scouts must have an active 2020/21 membership or she may not receive rewards and/or Cookie Dough earned
- All money and product transactions must be receipted and signed by the Troop Product Manager and parent/guardian
- Unsold product may not be returned to the troop or council. Once signed for, the person who signs the receipt is financially responsible for any cookies that have not been sold
- Girl Scouts must be supervised by an adult while taking orders (in person and/or online) and while delivering products

### Booth Sales

- A booth sale is any sale that occurs at a stationary site and **may only happen 3/5-3/21**
- A Girl Scout must be present at all times and only Girl Scouts may sell cookies at booth sites
- Booth sites may host one Girl Scout plus an adult- up to four Girl Scouts plus two adults
- **All booth sites** must be coordinated through the troop with the Troop Product Manager

### Booth Etiquette Guidelines

Booth sales give Girl Scouts the opportunity to learn new skills, to promote Girl Scouting, live the Girl Scout Promise and Law, and to sell more cookies. Remember to follow safety, public relations, and business guidelines. Please keep in mind that selling Girl Scout Cookies at community booth sites is a privilege granted to us by local businesses.

*This privilege, if abused, could cause all Girl Scouts to lose the opportunity for additional sales at these places of business. If complaints arise, you may be asked to leave and removed from future booth sites.*

#### As a Girl Scout, I will...

- Have fun! Be polite and friendly.
- Wear my uniform, vest or sash, or my pins to identify myself as a Girl Scout.
- Remember that my behavior reflects on ALL Girl Scouts.
- Say THANK YOU to all customers regardless of whether or not they purchase cookies.
- Only ask on the way out.
- Not talk loudly, run, or play while at the cookie booth.
- Share my reason for selling cookies with customers.
- Remove all empty boxes and leave the space cleaner than when I arrived.

#### As a Girl Scout parent/guardian, I will...

- Respect adults and businesses by being a model of the Girl Scout Law and not engaging in conflict at sites.
- Follow the specific site rules set individually by each business and location.
- Leave siblings at home and have a second adult if 3 or 4 Girl Scouts are selling at a site.
- Remember I am representing and therefore responsible for the reputation of Girl Scouts of Western Washington in our community.
- Call my troop immediately if we cannot attend a booth site.

### Girl Scout Rewards

- Please refer to page 12 of the *2021 Family Guide* for descriptions and details of each reward.
- Cookie Dough rewards are loaded onto a Key2Prepaid Mastercard. If your Girl Scout has never received a Key2Prepaid Cookie Dough card, one will be mailed directly to the home address listed in your MyGS account. If your Girl Scout previously earned a Key2Prepaid Cookie Dough card, funds will be added to the existing card.
- Please review the reward choices with your Girl Scout and mark the choices below. Turn into your Troop Product Manager so the correct reward is entered for the level of packages your Girl Scout sells. The Product Program Team will contact your Girl Scout in April if she has earned a reward that requires a registration date, color choice, and/or the Top Cookie Seller package.

Girls who sell less than 395 packages will receive appropriate reward for their level sold. Girls who sell 395+ packages may choose to exchange all rewards 65-395 for \$35 in Cookie Dough (CD). Girls who sell 500+ packages should indicate choice of reward **OR** CD - 500+ rewards are **not** cumulative. Girls who choose a lower reward than packages sold will receive CD for the balance earned.
