Mermaid and Dragon Egg

The goal is to get the dragon egg across the finish line before the mermaid guesses who has it. This game is similar to "Fisherman" or "Red Light Green Light" with a twist.

One person (mermaid) starts at one end of a yard, open field, or end of a living room with an object that is an "egg". The other people (small dragons) start at the other end.

The mermaid says while facing away: "One egg, two egg, blue egg, pink egg." While they say that phrase, the small dragons make their way (run, walk, skip, crawl, etc.) to the mermaid to try and pick up the egg.

Once the mermaid is done saying her phrase, the mermaid turns around quick to face the small dragons. Small dragons freeze and the mermaid see's if anyone is moving.



If the mermaid see's anyone move, they send them back and mermaid turns around and starts again.

Once the small dragons have the egg that was placed by the mermaids fin, they must try to get it back to their starting line without the mermaid guessing who is holding it. After each time the mermaid says the phrase "1 egg, 2 egg, blue egg, pink egg!"

This process and phrase will repeat until the small dragons either cross their starting line or the mermaid makes a correct guess as to who holds the egg. If the mermaid guesses before the small dragons cross their line, Mermaid wins, and it starts over. Use strategy to win!
