



Teamwork Thursday Hug a Tree

Goal: The blindfolded person tries to guess which tree their leader took them to.

What you'll need:

- A green spot or area with several trees to pick from.
- A blindfold of some sort.
- A buddy or few people to play.
- Decent shoes.

How to play:

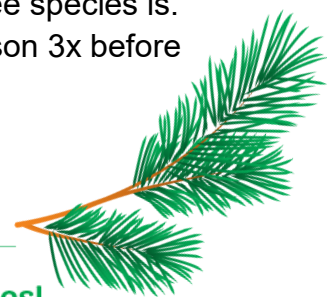
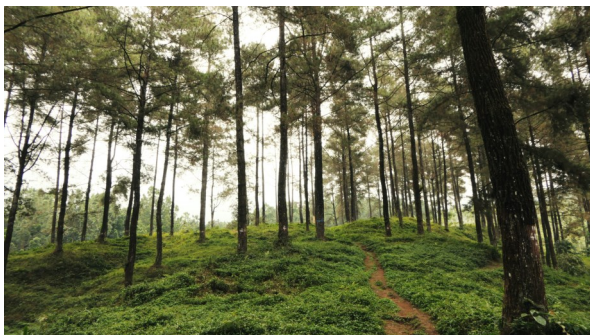
- Decide who will be blindfolded and who will not.
- The person who is NOT blindfolded chooses a tree (don't say out loud where it is or what it looks like).
- The leader (not blind folded) steers their blindfolded person through the area of tree's towards their tree of choice. Pick a zig-zag or twirly path that is hard to memorize!



- Once they both get to the chosen tree, the blind folded person gets a couple minutes to examine the tree, staying blindfolded.
- The leader then takes them back to where they started, removes the blindfold, and that person now must try and find and guess the right tree. They should get at least 3 guesses.
- Switch places and do it again!

DO IT UP EVEN MORE:

- Try to guess what the tree species is.
- Spin the blindfolded person 3x before beginning.
- Put a time limit on it.
