



## Try-It Tuesday Horcrux Hunt

### Supplies

Hide 7 small unique objects around your home, neighborhood, or even a park and create a list of directions and clue's that helps other's find the objects.

#### You will need:

- Paper
- Writing utensil
- Several small objects to hide
- A buddy/adult if you are going away from home

*\*This activity is for fun and it can be made difficult or easy. It can be done in a small home or big space. Please make sure you are being safe and using social distancing when at a public space.\**



### Instructions

1. Gather your objects to hide.
2. Note on your directions your starting point.
3. Hide your Horcruxes one at a time.
4. In between each hiding spot, write down the directions you took to get there. You can add in your surroundings, or landmarks.
5. When you finish, give it to your buddy and see if they can find all the Horcrux's.
6. **CHALLENGE!!** If you own a compass, use compass directions and have the seeker also use the compass. This is a great way to learn or teach another person how to use a compass.
