## Teamwork Thursday Mini-Carnival Day

Have a mini-Carnival day! You won't need much, and you can do these games inside with as many people as you want! Use the rooms and spaces in your home to set up the games.

### Supplies

- Chocolate Kisses or some wrapped candy
- Empty cups and jars (10)
- Pen or marker
- Paper
- Bandanas or scarves (3)
- 3 small balls
- 3 small stuffed animals
- Apples
- 1 big bowl of water
- 5 bowls
- Beanie babies or something weighted you can toss

### Kissing booth

Put the chocolates or candy in a jar and have everyone guess how many there are. The closest gets to keep the candy.



### Pin Drop

Set up the jars/cups close together and take turns dropping the pin from a small distance away to see how many jars you make it in.

### Juggle Challenge

Set up your 3 different juggling materials. Try and juggle each thing and see how well you do.

### Bob for Apples

Fill a big bowl or bucket with water. Add your apples or choice fruit and take turns bobbing for the fruit.

*You can alter this game if you don't want to use water or bob for anything.*

### Bean Bag Toss

Set up your bowls so they are one in front of the other. Make a spot to toss from. Toss your "bean bags" and see how many you can get.
