



Girl Scouts Open New Doors in Tacoma

SEATTLE – June 3, 2021 – Girl Scouts of Western Washington (GSWW) is excited to announce the grand opening of its new retail location in the Tacoma area at Prosser Plaza on June 4, 2021.

While the new retail space is primarily dedicated to online order fulfillment and inventory storage, it also features a small showroom with merchandise on hand for walk-in customers. The store is stocked mainly with core products needed by Girl Scout troops and members, including badges and requirements, uniforms, bridging and badge kits.

“Given the shifts we’ve had to make, we considered how to best support our members and the communities we intend to serve going forward and focus our dollars in a way that best meets our mission and vision. GSWW made the decision in 2017 to sell its DuPont Program Center to find a location more accessible to membership across the region. Relocating the store was a priority for the local Girl Scout community. In December of 2020, GSWW announced that the Cowlitz Indian Tribe purchased the DuPont Program Center.
