

Outdoor Sleeping Units

Pioneer: This Outdoor Village has contains three cabins. The cook shelter has running water, two fireplaces, and a fire circle. This unit also has a dock with a view of other units on the lake. The BIFFY's are a little up on the hill closer to the cook shelter. Parking is unit adjacent.









Totem Landing: This Outdoor unit has seven of the Adirondack shelters, each sleeps four, two additional Adirondacks sleep six each. The beds are strung canvas bunks on log frames without mattresses, ensolite pads are provided. Cook shelter with fireplace, with cold water, and outdoor fire circle. There is a BIFFY at this unit. Parking is unit adjacent. Totem Landing is the closest unit to the wetland and our bird blind for bird watching.









Primitive: Bring your own tent! Great inland secluded site, cook shelter, water and fire circle available. It is a very quiet, attractive forest setting with a BIFFY. Access to hiking trails. Parking is a little away from the shelter.











Outdoor Sleeping Units









Lakeside: The Lakeside unit has five open air cabins, each sleeps 6. Sleeping arrangements are beds/bunks with mattresses. There is a BIFFY, water, fire circle, and a cook shelter with two fireplaces. The unit is right next to Lake Bennettsen, with a great view. Parking located in the cook shelter driveway. Lakeside is located on the road across from the boathouse.













Hilltop: Five platform tents, sleeps 4, with porches, wheelchair accessible via the road, with boardwalk/ramps connecting the cook shelter to two tents and an accessible BIFFY. Water, and fire circle. Hilltop has a great view of the lake from the cook shelter's deck. The fire circle is just outside of the cook shelter. Parking is next to the cook shelter.











Yurt Village: Five Yurt shelters that each sleep six. The yurt closest to the cook shelter is wheelchair accessible. The ground is mostly even in this unit. The fire circle on the same side as the wheelchair accessible yurt. Yurts are a wood frame with canvas side and 2 doors. The sun roof in the center of the ceiling my be opened to vent the yurt. This site has a BIFFY, water, fire circle, and a cook shelter with two fireplaces.















Ark: One floating cabin with deck that sleeps 12. The bed style is Navy bunks with strung canvas without mattresses and an ensolite pad is provided. Outdoor village unit equipment is provided with one propane stove and a metal fire pit on the deck. The A-frame on shore sleeps 4. Site has water, BIFFY and an additional fire circle on s unit has a great view of the whole lake.

Indoor Sleeping Units









Ulali: This facility has three bedrooms for a capacity of 8, a single bathroom & shower. Other amenities include a kitchen with range and refrigerator, living room with chairs and a sofa. Building has a skylight and is wheelchair accessible including the shower, and is close to central camp. This unit has electrical lights, outlets and heat. *Not Available June-September*





Indoor Sleeping Units













Hacienda: This facility is a two-story building with heat and electric lights. Downstairs has a meeting/dining area with complete bathrooms and showers, the kitchen has a range and refrigerator. Upstairs is one large open room with a loft. Mattresses are provided without beds or bunks for a slumber party atmosphere. Fire circle in front, and dock on the lake.









Upper Tilakum: The upstairs sleeps 6 in one main room, and 2 each in three separate rooms for a total bed count of 12. There are 4 bathrooms, 3 showers and dining and meeting area. The three small rooms open to the outside. Electric lights, heat, a kitchen with range & refrigerator. Beds are bunks with mattresses provided. The main room and one bathroom are wheelchair accessible. Fire circle is nearby.









Lower Tilakum: The downstairs area of Tilakum building has one very large room that sleeps 14 in bunks arranged around the perimeter walls. Mattresses are provided. There is a separate bathroom with showers. This unit is heated with electric lights, a kitchen area with range and refrigerator, fire circle nearby.



Lodge & Kitchen:

Dining and meeting are with fireplace, electricity, heat and bathrooms, capacity of 200. There is a small adjoining room with a fireplace and heat. The main room is convertible to two rooms. Institutional kitchen with gas range & oven, convection oven, walk-in freezer and cooler, commercial dishwasher, etc. Complete with cooking, dining, and serving equipment for 200. Wheelchair accessible. This is not a sleeping area.
