



## The Award of Excellence Scholarship

Each spring Girl Scouts of Western Washington presents the Award of Excellence scholarship to distinguished leaders in order to support them in their pursuit of higher education. The Award is given to top applicants who have demonstrated personal excellence in academic, community, and Girl Scout life. This scholarship is funded by a grant from Ericsson.

Two Award of Excellence recipients will be selected and awarded a one-time scholarship of \$5,000.

To be eligible, you must be:

- A Gold Award Girl Scout\*
- A registered Girl Scout in the Girl Scouts of Western Washington council
- Younger than 22 years old
- Enrolled as a full-time student at an accredited college or university for the 2022-2023 academic year\*\*
- \* Members currently in the process of earning the Gold Award may apply for this scholarship **if your Gold Award Proposal has been reviewed and approved before April 29, 2022**. If selected for the award, receipt of the scholarship is contingent upon successful completion of your project and having your **Gold Award Final Report Form approved by August 17, 2022**.
- \*\* High school students and current college students are both eligible to apply. If selected for the award, receipt of the scholarship is contingent upon enrollment for the 2022-23 academic year.
