



GOLD AWARD COMMENDATION LETTERS AND SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES

Earning the Girl Scout Gold Award is a major accomplishment—congratulations! Make sure that hard work gets recognized and celebrated. This document includes information about how to request special commendation letters for Gold Award Girl Scouts as well as information about some of the many college scholarships offered to Gold Award Girl Scouts. As you look over this resource, here are a few things to keep in mind about the lists:

- Contact information may change or become outdated—we try to keep it as accurate as possible, but it's always a good idea for you to double check if you're not sure.
- May be incomplete—feel free to search for other prominent individuals and/or colleges that interest you.

Being listed here does not guarantee the person will send a response.

When sending notes to people asking for letters of commendation, please include:

- Gold Award Girl Scouts's full name
- Gold Award Girl Scout's troop number, service unit number and council
- A short description of the Gold Award Take Action Project
- Date for an awards ceremony (if scheduled)
- It is also courteous to include a self-addressed stamped envelope when writing to private individuals or organizations. This is usually not necessary when writing to government officials.

Remember that the purpose of a congratulatory letter is to honor the Gold Award Girl Scout and that each person you write may be getting many, many requests. This is not a race or a contest to see who can get the most letters. Often a few letters are more meaningful than a scrapbook full of letters that ends up on a shelf. Sometimes the best thing is a letter or two from an admired prominent person in a field of interest to the Gold Award Girl Scout.

Please pick and choose so that people who are willing to write a letter do not get overwhelmed and decide to stop accepting requests.

College and University Scholarship Opportunities

Many institutions offer scholarships. Be sure to ask any colleges you are exploring if they offer any funding for Gold Award Girl Scouts. Also check out the [GSUSA's scholarship search feature](#) for some listed opportunities.

Purchasing an American Flag to Commemorate Your Gold Award Take Action Project

You can purchase a US flag that has flown over the United States Capitol Building in Washington, D.C., by ordering it from your [US Representative or Senator](#).

Certificate of authenticity: You may request that your flag be flown on a certain date such as a birthday. A certificate showing it was flown over the Capitol accompanies each flag. If you mention in your letter or on your request form that this flag is for any specific occasion, that information will be included on the certificate. If you are requesting a specific date, please make your request at least 4 weeks prior to that date.

Fabric and size of flags: All flags are made in the United States. The cotton flags come in two sizes: 3'x5' or 5'x8'. The nylon flags come in the same size as the cotton and one additional size: 4'x6'.

Pricing: The specific prices vary from office to office. The prices include only the costs of the flag itself, the certificate, and shipping and handling.
