## Roles Needed for Success



**Troop Coordinator\***: Assists the troop by managing the roles and responsibilities of the troop volunteers. Serve as the “head” of the troop and oversee troop roles and functions.



**Badge Planner\***: Help maintain schedule and plans for badge work. A troop may have multiple badge planners to assist the troop.



**Troop Treasurer**: Leads the maintenance and management of troop dues, cookie proceeds, and banking.



**Troop Communicator\***: Attends local Service Unit meetings, reports to all adult leadership, and shares important info with the troop.



**Product Manager**: Leads the implementation and execution of the Girl Scout Cookie Program within your troop.



**Troop Helper**: Assist with troop responsibilities as needed. May be asked to assist with supervision at troop meetings, events, or overnight travel trips.
