Skilled Camp Facilities Volunteer

POSITION SUMMARY:

Skilled Camp Facilities Volunteers help with maintenance, projects, and repairs at camp facilities that require multiple people and/or specific skills. Camp Facility Volunteers possess specific skills, certifications, documented expertise, or professional experience that can be utilized for more advanced facility support needs.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Assist site staff with projects requiring skilled labor which may include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Electrical work
 - b. Plumbing
 - c. Carpentry
 - d. Construction
 - e. Masonry
 - f. Mowing
 - g. Projects requiring more than one person such as tree removal, roofing repairs, ladder work, etc.
- Follow staff directions, with safety as the highest priority
- Work as a team with GSWW staff and other volunteers.

SKILLS & QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. **Age:** Must be 18 or older.
- 2. **Physical Ability:** Possess ability, balance, and stamina to participate in potentially physically demanding tasks based on the nature of the specific volunteer work.
- 3. **Knowledge of Tools and Equipment:** Must demonstrate knowledge of safe handling for any tools, equipment, or machinery that will be used.
 - A valid Driver's license, clean driving record, and completion of GSWW driver training is required to operate any camp vehicles.
 - b. Must have certification, documented experience, or demonstrated expertise to operate power tools or machinery such as chainsaws, powered saws, and nail guns.
 - c. Must have certification or documented experience if providing skilled labor such as electrical work, plumbing, construction, etc.
- 4. **Good Judgement:** Ability to make good decisions quickly and independently to ensure a safe environment.
- 5. **Personal Integrity:** Demonstrate honesty, credibility, and dependability
- 6. **Interpersonal Skills:** Ability to work well with people from diverse social, cultural, ethnic, and economic backgrounds
- 7. **Outdoor exposure:** Willingness to work outdoors in a variety of weather and with potential exposure to biting insects and stinging nettles.
- 8. **Background Check:** Must complete and pass a criminal background check.
