## Steps in Interactive Modeling

Briefly state what you will model, and why.

Model the behavior exactly as you expect them to do it ed (the right way, not the wrong way, and without describing what you're doing unless you need to "show" a thinking process).

Ask what they noticed. (You may need to do some prompting, but soon they will notice every little detail, especially as they gain expertise with this practice.)

Invite one or more girl scouts to model the same way you did and again, ask everyone what they noticed.

Have everyone model while you observe and coach them.

Provide feedback, naming specific, positive actions you notice and redirecting respectfully but clearly. when needed.
