## **For Your Troop**

- Forms for troop
  - o Trip Action Plan
  - o <u>Incident Report Form</u> Just in case!
  - o <u>Emergency Procedures Card</u> Just in case!
- Preparation
  - o Complete the <u>Getting Started Online Modules</u>
  - o Complete the <u>Day Trip Planning Module or In Person</u>
  - o Complete the <u>Basic Overnight Module</u>
  - o Complete the Outdoor Overnight Workshop If outdoors
  - o Complete the Travel Planning with girls Workshop Or
    - Complete <u>Domestic Troop Travel Module (20 minutes)</u> Required for all adults
  - At least one adult who is First aid/CPR certified\*
  - o Review relevant <u>Safety Activity Checkpoints</u>
  - o Review Administering Medication to a Minor Policy

## For Individual Girls

- o Membership
- o Girl Permissions & Heath History All Sections that apply
- o <u>Parent/Guardian Permission for Overnight, High Risk Activities, and Sensitive</u> <u>Topics</u> – May be required depending on activities
- o Complete the <u>Travel Workshop for Teens</u> Highly Recommended

## **For Adults**

- o Membership & Criminal Background Check on file
- o Adult Health History Record
- o Transportation Card Required for adults who are driving

<sup>\*</sup>Wilderness first aid is required if more than 30 mins from emergency services
